Staff from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (staff) conducted a Comprehensive Anti-Drug and Alcohol Misuse Plan (Plan) inspection on November 4, 2013 at Targa Sound Terminal, Tacoma, WA. Targa Sound Terminal (Targa) is a subsidiary of Targa Resources and the Plan is a companywide document.

This inspection documents that Targa Sound Refining is properly conducting its anti-drug and alcohol misuse programs per the Targa Plan, 49 CFR Part 40 and Part 199. The inspection included a records review and onsite inspection of one local Targa approved, specimen collection site.
